### **International Journal of Educational Media and Technology**

The *International Journal of Educational Media and Technology*, collaboratively published once per year by the JAEMS (Japan Association for Educational Media Studies) in Japan and the KAEIM (Korean Association for Educational Information and Media) in Korea, is the premier academic journal for the field focusing entirely on research and practice in media studies in education and training.

The first issue consists of invitation papers only, which were recommended by the Editorial Board among those papers accepted for concurrent sessions of ICoME 2006, or International Conference for Media in Education, held on July 18, 2006, at National Olympics Memorial Youth Center, Tokyo, Japan. Upon submission of the paper, not only Korean and Japanese reviewers were assigned, but also an international editor was assigned to make the review rigorous and helpful to include only quality papers.

# **Guidelines for Contributors: Manuscript Submission**

Submission of manuscript to this journal is understood to imply that it, or substantial parts of it, have not been published, accepted for publication, or submitted for consideration elsewhere. Manuscripts should be submitted electronically. Electronic submissions should be sent as e-mail attachments using a standard word processing program, such as MSWORD. When the accepted paper is submitted in final form, please send it as e-mail attachment. Papers are accepted only in English.

# **Manuscript Preparation**

Manuscripts should be up to 10 pages in length (including tables, figures, references, footnotes, pictures and etc.) in final publication format and must conform to the style of the *Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association* (5th ed., 2001). The name(s), affiliation(s), address(es), and phone and fax number(s) should appear on a separate cover page. To ensure anonymity in the review process, names of the author(s) should not appear elsewhere in the manuscript. The title should be short (12 words maximum), informative and contain the major keywords. An abstract of 100 - 150 words and up to 5 keywords should be typed on a separate page. Manuscripts that do not conform to these specifications will be returned for proper style change. Contributors should bear in mind that they are addressing an international audience.

### **Tables and Figures**

Tables must be typed out on separate sheets and not included as part of the text. Figures submitted must be of high enough standard for direct reproduction. The approximate position of tables and figures should be indicated in the manuscript.

#### Proofs

Page proofs are sent to the designated author. They must be checked carefully and returned within a definite period of time.

### **Review Process**

Submissions are refereed by three individuals identified by the Editorial Board. A manuscript is judged on the basis of originality, scholarship, clarity of discourse, and significance, as well as the degree to which the subject matter contributes to the practice of media studies in educational practices. Referees' notes and editorial comments are usually communicated to the author when revision is requested. The Editorial Board retains the final authority to accept or reject manuscripts.

Papers accepted become the copyright of the Journal, unless otherwise specifically agreed. No limitation will be placed on the personal freedom of authors to copy or to use in subsequent work, material contained in their papers.
